

**NOTICE OF ADVICE**

As of November 23, 2006, in the state of New York, patients may receive Direct Access to physical therapy by a physical therapist with three years of practical experience.

This law also requires that a patient without a prescription is informed, in writing, that there is a possibility that treatment may not be covered by your health care plan or insurer without a referral from a physician and that such treatment may be a covered expense if rendered with a referral.

Direct access to physical therapy is good for a 30 day continuous period or a maximum of 10 visits, whichever comes first, and begins on the date of your initial evaluation appointment.
